## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

### Assembly Instructions for **L1336D** and **L1336M**, 32-Gallon Receptacle

#### **Assembly Recommendations**

To prevent scratching on any of the finished pieces, we recommend assembling the unit on packing material (paper and cardboard). Do not drag assembled unit on any surface. The assembly is a two-person operation.

#### **Mounting Recommendations**

For surface mounted product, we recommend the use of stainless steel mounting studs. For any other follow assembly instructions.

#### **Cleaning Recommendations**

For cleaning, use mild household cleansers or soap and water. Do not use vinyl cleansers or protectants.

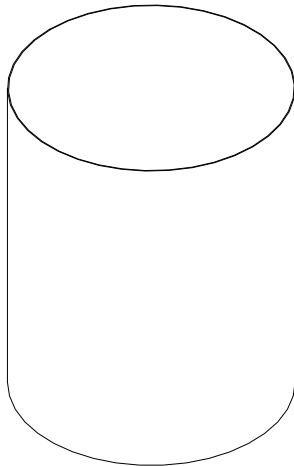

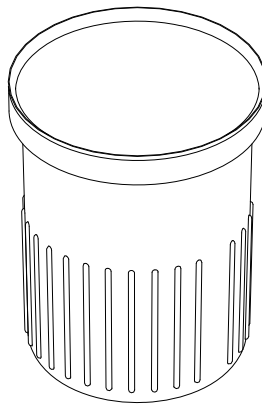

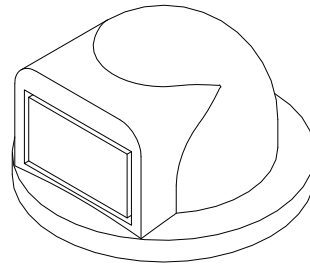

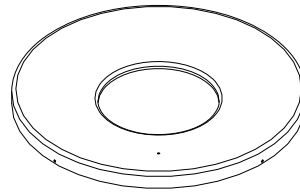

**Diagram #1**

1. Place receptacle in appropriate location with opening facing up.
2. Place plastic liner inside receptacle with opening facing up.
3. Attach grommet end of fabric tether to receptacle using one of the existing holes in the top portion of the receptacle as shown in Diagram #1 (fasteners not included).
4. Attach spring snap, on end of fabric tether, to tie-down ring on contour or dome top as shown in Diagram #1.
5. Place contour or dome top on receptacle.
